Training and Experience Required:

Education and Experience:

High School Diploma or G.E.D. required. Must have good performance as an Inspector/Sr Inspector (minimum 65 wks), have demonstrated proficiency in the specialized duties and functions of this position. Must have successfully completed all refresher training and have demonstrated the ability to communicate effectively and to work efficiently under tension and pressure.

Other:

Must have "Q" access authorization, a valid driver's license, and maintain weapons proficiency in accordance with DOE IMD 6102.


Physical and Mental Requirements:

Must meet the physical and mental requirements as set forth in 10 CFR 1046 for defensive combative protective force personnel for continued employment. Must be able to react and be capable of providing any support necessary in an emergency situation. (See WSI Standard Practices 3-05 and 3-07 for detailed information.)

Summary and Purpose of Job:

To coordinate the activities of protective personnel in a specified area or operation. Sergeants assigned to special units will perform specialized work in addition to normal security duties and must have knowledge of the orders, procedures and requirements regarding such assignments. Shall be capable of performing strenuous emergency response duties as required in General Orders, Station Orders and other Emergency Procedures and supplements as an integral part of the mission assigned to the security force for the protection of nuclear weapons and components and other sensitive classified information and material. Otherwise acts as directed by the Captain/Lieutenant responsible for the assigned area.
