


Below you will find general program information related to members enrolled and members certified for treatment of health conditions in the WTC Health Program.

Overall Enrollment: Responder and Survivor





The date labels correspond to the end of the quarter (i.e., December 2016 represents cumulative members through December 31, 2016).

New Enrollees Past 24 Months





New Enrollees Responders and Survivors Past 12 Months





WTC Health Program Enrollment by Member Type





WTC Health Program Member Age Distribution





WTC Health Program Member Type by Gender





WTC Health Program Enrollment by State






Top 10 Certified Conditions



Top 15 Certified Cancers






Members with Certifications Age Distribution



Members with Aerodigestive Certifications Age Distribution





Members with Mental Health Certifications Age Distribution




