


Below you will find general program information related to members enrolled and members certified for treatment of health conditions in the WTC Health Program.

Overall Enrollment: Responder and Survivor




Note: The Program started on July 1, 2011, and at that time, 56,196 Responders were "grandfathered" from previous Federal activities. On September 29, 2011, 4,751 Survivors were likewise "grandfathered". The chart above depicts enrollment from the beginning of the Program, starting with "grandfathered" members and the cumulative addition of new members each quarter. The date labels correspond to the end of the quarter (i.e., September 2018 represents cumulative members through September 30th, 2018).

New Enrollees Past 24 Months



New Enrollees Responders and Survivors Past 24 Months




WTC Health Program Enrollment by Member Type





WTC Health Program Member Age Distribution





WTC Health Program Member Type by Gender





Note: Of the 97,176 members enrolled in the program, 18,570 members are served through the Nationwide Provider Network.


Members with Certifications by Zadroga Act Categories of Conditions



Top 10 Certified Conditions





Top 15 Certified Cancers





Number of Members with Only the Number of Certifications





Members with Certifications Age Distribution*








