
Single-state foodborne illness outbreaks linked to unpasteurized milk and relationship to legal sale, 2013 –2018



In some states where sale of unpasteurized milk is illegal, people may get unpasteurized milk through programs called "cow shares" or "herd shares." These programs allow people to participate in partial "ownership" of animals on someone else's farm and receive unpasteurized milk from those animals.
