#### VACCINES TO PREVENT MPOX

The purpose of this resolution is to add a vaccine for the prevention of mpox to the Vaccines for Children Program.

# **Eligible Groups**

- Children aged 18 years of age at increased risk of mpox, including:
  - o Persons who are gay, bisexual and other men who have sex with men, transgender or nonbinary people who in the past 6 months have had:
    - At least 1 sexually transmitted disease
    - More than 1 sex partner
    - Sex at a commercial sex venue
    - Sex in association with a large public event in a geographic area where mpox transmission is occurring
  - o Persons who are sexual contacts of the persons described above
  - o Persons who anticipate experiencing any of the situations described above

# **Recommended Vaccination Schedule and Intervals**

• Two doses, 28 days apart

# **Recommended dosage**

Refer to product package inserts

# **Contraindications and Precautions**

#### Contraindications

• Severe allergic reaction (e.g., anaphylaxis) after a previous dose or to a vaccine component as listed in the package insert Package-Insert-JYNNEOS (fda.gov).

# Precautions

- Simultaneous administration of mpox vaccine with COVID-19 vaccine (due to a hypothetical increased risk for myocarditis/pericarditis following vaccination)
- Moderate or severe acute illness, with or without fever
