

Davidson Trauma Scale (DTS)

Description

The Davidson Trauma Scale (DTS) was developed as a self-rating for measuring the frequency and severity of Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) symptoms in three clusters: intrusion, avoidance, and hyperarousal. [Davidson 1997] The data set includes the seven scores of DTS.

212 participants

Data Collection Methods

DTS instrument was administered on the first day in clinic. The scores were derived from the raw responses later.
