Dear Colleague:

The Centers for Disease Control is pleased to announce award recipients for funding opportunity announcement (FOA): CDC-RFA-PS11-1103 – *Sexually Transmitted Diseases/Human Immunodeficiency Virus Prevention Training Centers*.

The purpose of this program is to support a National Network of Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD)/Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Prevention Training Centers (NNPTC). The Prevention Training Centers (PTCs) will provide training, curriculum development, and training assistance for the clinical management and prevention of Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STDs) and the prevention of HIV for health care professionals, prevention specialists, and program directors and managers in the United States. The PTCs will train a range of health professionals including clinicians in the public and private sector who diagnose, treat, and manage patients with STDs and HIV; prevention providers in public, private, and community sectors who are responsible for the implementation or supervision of STD/HIV prevention programs in community, health care, or criminal justice settings; and federal, state, and local public health professionals, especially those working in STD/HIV prevention programs.

A total of 17 awards were made through a competitive process. The awards will establish 16 regional centers to develop and provide training in three focus areas and one national resource center:

- Eight centers will provide training in STD clinical and laboratory services, HIV prevention in care, and HIV biomedical prevention interventions. (Part I)
- Five centers will provide training in HIV behavioral interventions. (Part II)
- Three centers will provide training in STD/HIV partner services and STD/HIV program management support. (Part III)
- One center will provide coordination and support for the NNPTC and nationally focused training activities, initiatives and projects. (Part IV)
