

# **1998 National Alternative High School Youth Risk Behavior Survey**

## **Data Documentation**

### **Introduction**

The Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance System (YRBSS) is an epidemiologic surveillance system that was established by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to monitor the prevalence of youth behaviors that most influence health. The 1998 national alternative high school Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) is one component of the YRBSS.

The YRBSS focuses on priority health-risk behaviors established during youth that result in the most significant mortality, morbidity, disability, and social problems during both youth and adulthood. These include: behaviors that result in unintentional and intentional injuries; tobacco use; alcohol and other drug use; sexual behaviors that results in HIV infection, other sexually transmitted diseases (STDs), and unintended pregnancies; dietary behaviors; and physical activity.

Results from the alternative high school YRBS will be used by CDC to: 1) identify the prevalence and age of initiation of priority health-risk behaviors among students attending alternative high schools; and 2) identify the need for school health programs and policies for students attending alternative high schools.

To make data more widely available, standardized data and documentation files have been prepared for distribution over the Internet.

## **Methodology**

The 1998 national alternative high school Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) used a three-stage cluster sample design to produce a nationally representative sample of 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students in the United States who attend alternative senior high schools. The target population consisted of all secondary schools in the 50 states and the District of Columbia, including public, private, and Catholic schools which had self-designated themselves as “alternative,” had some high school-level grades, were not a school within another school, and served students at risk of not graduating. Very small schools, making up less than 1% of the total enrollment of all alternative high schools were excluded from the frame. In addition, vocational schools that served a “pullout” population were excluded from the frame.

The first-stage sampling frame included 121 primary sampling units (PSUs) consisting of groups of alternative high schools that are geographically close together. Forty-eight PSUs were selected without replacement with probabilities proportional to school enrollment size. The size measure was a weighted combination of minority and non-minority enrollment, thus increasing the probability of selection of high minority PSUs.

At the second stage of selection, 142 alternative high schools were selected with probability proportional to school enrollment size. The size measure was a weighted combination of minority and non-minority enrollment, thus increasing the probability of selection of high minority schools. The final stage of sampling consisted of randomly selecting classes within each school.

## **Description of Alternative Senior High Schools**

Alternative high schools were defined as schools which serve students who are at risk of not progressing in regular high schools and, as a result, not graduating, as well as students who have already gotten into disciplinary trouble, usually related to drug use or violence. Within the national sample, schools can be described along two dimensions, residential status of students and the primary type of population served. Thirteen of the alternative schools (11% of students) were considered residential facilities with students spending nearly 24 hours per day, 5 to 7 days per week within the facility. One school (1% of students) was multi-site and contained both residential and day treatment programs. The remaining schools (87% of students) were considered non-residential.

The vast majority of alternative schools (80 schools, 74% of students) did not serve a single type of student population, but rather served multiple types of student populations. Of the remaining alternative high schools, the type of student population served included pregnant teens (5 schools, 6% of students), adjudicated youth (13 schools, 8% of students), and students with emotional or behavioral problems (17 schools, 13% of students).

## **Survey Procedures**

Survey procedures were designed to protect student privacy and allow for anonymous participation. The 88-item questionnaire was administered in the classroom by trained data collectors. Students recorded responses on the computer-scanable

questionnaire booklet. Parental consent was obtained prior to survey administration, in accord with school policy.

### **Response Rate**

A total of 8918 questionnaires were completed in 115 schools. The school response rate was 81 percent and the student response rate was 82 percent for an overall response rate of 66 percent.

### **Weighting**

A weighting factor was applied to each student record to adjust for nonresponse and the oversampling of African-American and Hispanic students in the sample. The final, overall weights were scaled so that the weighted count of the students was equal to the total sample size and the weighted proportions of students in each race/ethnic group matched national population projections.

### **Variance Estimation**

To calculate sampling variances for a design of the complexity described here the SUDAAN package produced by the Research Triangle Institute was used. In applying it to the 1998 YRBS dataset, we recommend using the “with replacement” sampling option.
