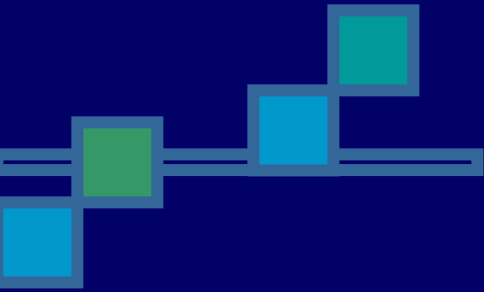
## 8 Regional Strategic Planning Workshops for Hospitals to Implement Rapid HIV Testing in L&D

- Follow-up evaluation underway
- Lessons learned
  - Many myths about who can offer testing
  - CLIA& CAP regulations incongruent
  - Ryan White language prohibited opt-out
- Model for Emergency Departments

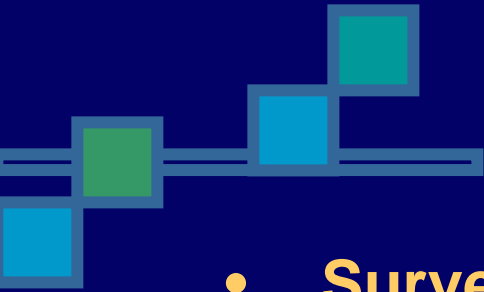

# Perinatal HIV Sentinel Event Review Pilot Project

- New program announcement
  - Review of applications underway
- Grantee will collaborate with NFIMR to:  
(National Fetal & Infant Mortality Review at ACOG)
  1. Investigate care of HIV-infected women & their infants as sentinel events using FIMR methods (Medical record review and interviews)
  2. Implement quality improvement via local community action team
  3. Develop methodology and pilot in 2005-2006
