Summary Proceedings

The Thirty-Ninth meeting of the National Center for Injury Prevention and Control (NCIPC; Injury Center) Board of Scientific Counselors (BSC) was convened on Wednesday, June 8, 2022 via teleconference and Zoom. The BSC met in closed session in accordance with the Privacy Act and the Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA). Dr. Arlene Greenspan served as Chair.

This meeting was closed to the public in accordance with the determination that it was concerned with matters exempt from mandatory disclosure under Sections 552b(c)(4) and 552b(c)(6), title 5, U.S. Code and Section 10(d) of the Federal Advisory committee Act, as amended (5 U.S.C. Appendix 2). The Scientific Review Officer explained policies and procedures regarding avoidance of conflict of interest situations; voting and priority rating; and confidentiality of application materials, committee discussions, and recommendations. Committee members absented themselves from the meeting during discussion of, and voting on, applications from their own institutions, or other applications in which there was a potential conflict of interest, real or apparent.

- 1. RFA-CE-22-002: Grants to Support New Investigators in Conducting Research Related to Preventing Interpersonal Violence Impacting Children and Youth. The SEP to conduct the primary peer review of the applications to this NOFO was convened as a virtual meeting via Zoom on March 8, 2022.
- 2. RFA-CE-22-004: Research Grants to Prevent Firearm-Related Violence and Injuries (R01). The SEP to conduct the primary peer review of the applications to this NOFO was convened as virtual meeting via Zoom on April 4-7, 2022.
- 3. PA-20-260 / PA-20-262: Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) Applications Submitted in Response to PA-20-260 and PA-20-262 Omnibus Solicitation of the National Institutes of Health (NIH), CDC, and Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for Small Business Innovation Research Grant Applications (Parent SBIR [R43/R44]). The SEPs to conduct the primary peer review of the applications to these NOFO was convened as virtual meeting via Zoom in March 2021 and July 2021.
