

## **Definitions**

- No Documented Diagnosis: Group that includes infants that are "In process," "Died / Parents declined services," "Non-residents or Moved out of jurisdiction," and "Unable to contact / Unresponsive / Unknown"
- LFU / LTD: Loss to Follow-up / Loss to Documentation
  - Sub group of those reported in "No Documented Diagnosis." Includes infants where families were Unable to be contacted or Unresponsive and Unknown cases
- Not Confirmed to be Receiving Early Intervention (EI): Group that includes infants that "Died / Parents declined services," "Non-residents or Moved out of
