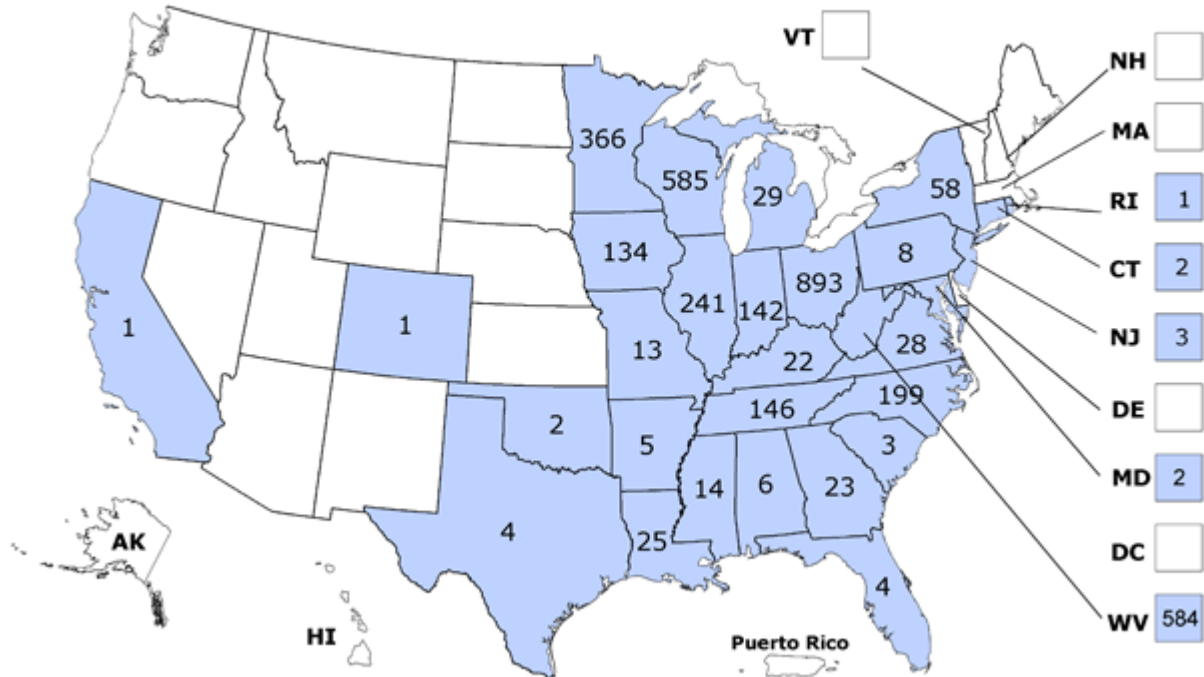


**California Serogroup Virus Neuroinvasive Disease Cases\* Reported by State, 1964-2008**

California Serogroup Virus Neuroinvasive Disease Cases\* Reported from 1964 through 2008 have been reported in Alabama (6), Arkansas (5), California (1), Colorado (1), Connecticut (2), Florida (4), Georgia (23), Illinois (241), Indiana (142), Iowa (134), Kentucky (22), Louisiana (25), Maryland (2), Michigan (29), Minnesota (366), Mississippi (14), Missouri (13), New Jersey (3), New York (58), North Carolina (199), Ohio (893), Oklahoma (2), Pennsylvania (8), Rhode Island (1), South Carolina (3), Tennessee (146), Texas (4), Virginia (28), West Virginia (584), and Wisconsin (585).
