 - pp.13 first line of Policy makers can: The MUTCD should recommend that all workers wear high visibility apparel that meets ANSI/ISEA 107-1999 American National
 Standard for High Visibility Safety Apparel. This standard represents the state of the art in materials and technology for high visibility garments.
- 3. pp.14 first line, should be ANSI/ISEA 107-1999 pp.14 last line in box should be [ANSI/ISEA 107-1999]
