# Roll Call/Welcome - Dr. Rashaun Roberts, DFO

Dr. Rashaun Roberts called to order the Advisory Board on Radiation and Worker Health at 1:00 pm EDT on April 20, 2022, A roll call of all ABRWH members confirmed that a quorum was present. The quorum was maintained throughout the meeting. Attendees declared conflicts of interest during roll call. Dr. Roberts turned the meeting over to Dr. Anderson.

# SEC Petition Status Update – Mr. Chuck Nelson, DCAS

Mr. Nelson reported DCAS has not received any new petitions since the Board's last meeting. DCAS is continuing to prepare an addendum to the evaluation report for petition SEC-0221 for Lawrence Livermore National Lab (LLNL) for the years 1990 to 1995. DCAS intends to publish the addendum by September 2023. DCAS and SC&A are continuing work on SEC petitions from Hanford, Savannah River, Los Alamos National Lab, Idaho National Lab, Argonne National Lab-West, Area IV Santa Susanna, Metals & Controls, DeSoto Avenue Facility, the Y-12 Plant, and the Pinellas Plant. DCAS continues to evaluate records for West Valley Demonstration Project to decide if an 83.14 petition is warranted for the years 1966-1968.

# Savannah River Site (SRS) Workgroup Update – Mr. Brad Clawson, SRS Work Group Chair

Mr Clawson described recent Workgroup activities and turned the meeting over to Bob Barton, SC&A. Mr. Barton first recounted that the Board had recommended adding an SEC class of subcontractor construction trades workers for the period October 1972 through December 1990. He then described five conclusions that SC&A had reached while evaluating the post-1990 period and summarized the discussion of those conclusions at the March 2023 Savanna River Work Group meeting. Following Mr. Barton's comments, Dr. John Cardarelli, DCAS, provided comments emphasizing DCAS's positions in from the March Work Group meeting. Additional discussion by Board members clarified the future actions expected from SC&A and DCAS.

### **Board Work Session**

Subcommittee and Work Group chairpersons reported on progress and planned activities. This included a discussion about the process for assigning tasks to SC&A. There was also a discussion about whether the Dose Reconstruction Review Methods Work Group should be discontinued. Following that, Dr. Roberts described public comments and responses from the December Board meeting.

After some discussion the Board decided to hold their December meeting in the vicinity of Livermore, CA, with the vicinity of Santa Susanna as a backup. The February 2024 telephone meeting will be on the 14<sup>th</sup>, and the April 2024 in-person meeting will be on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>.
