This memo seeks approval to change the name, period of coverage and text for the Madison Site (Speculite) on the DOE website. Last week, DOE OWA met with a representative of the Department of Labor and our office was reminded that sub-contractors of Atomic Weapons Employers (AWE) are not covered under the Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act (EEOICPA). As part of this reminder we were asked to examine the Madison Site description on our website as raising potential coverage problems for people who worked there during the AWE timeframe. DOL also brought to our attention that the federal register notice says "Spectrulite" and our website said "Speculite." The files support the federal register notice as being correct with regard to this issue.

In addition to these issues raised by DOL, our office has been working to more accurately define coverage periods under the DOE's Formerly Utilized Site Remediation Action Program (FUSRAP). In the case of the Madison Site, no cleanup work was ever performed as part of this program and therefore the designation of DOE for the years 1992-1998 is inaccurate. There are four claims at L'enfant plaza for people who claim employment at this location during the timeframe currently listed on the website as a "DOE."

Enclosed in this package is a printout from our website with the current information for Madison Site. A proposed new listing is also included. The revised listing is designed to fix all issues noted above. We have also included a page from the most recent federal register notice highlighting the current listing for this AWE.

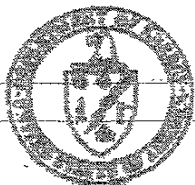

Facility Description: Dow Chemical operated the Madison Site under subcontract to Mallinckrodt Chemical Company. Dow supplied the AEC with materials (chemicals, induction heating equipment, and metal magnesium metal products) and services. In March 1960, Dow received an order for straightening uranium rods from Mallinckrodt.

Facility Description: The Dow facility in Madison, Illinois, supplied the AEC with materials (chemicals, induction heating equipment, and metal magnesium metal products) and services. Dow received a purchase order from Mallinckrodt in March 1960, for research and development on the extrusion of uranium metal and rod.

Although this site was designated as part of the Formerly Utilized Site Remediation Action Program (FUSRAP) in 1992, no remediation work ever took place under the DOE FUSRAP program prior that that program being transferred to the Army Corps of Engineers in 1997.
