

Live Satellite Broadcasts & Webcasts

Each year, the National Immunization Program presents three live satellite training courses which are simultaneously webcast for access on a personal computer. The course schedule varies from year to year but will usually include three of the following courses:

- **Adult Immunization**
- **Epidemiology and Prevention of Vaccine-Preventable Diseases** [4-Part Course]
- **The Immunization Encounter: Critical Issues**
- **Immunization Update** [offered annually]
- **Influenza: Preparing for the Next Pandemic**
- **Surveillance of Vaccine-Preventable Diseases**
