Basic Rules

- 1. JFTR only (no other)**
- 2. All Travel is LOCAL**

PCS Allowances

1. Member and Dependents Travel and Transportation
2. Household Goods (HHG)
3. Storage

PCS

Member and Dependents Travel and Transportation

1. **One Year from effective date of orders**
2. Travel by Privately Owned Conveyance (POC)
3. Monetary Allowance in Lieu of Transportation plus flat per diem (MALT PLUS)
 - MALT = paid on a “per mile” basis for the official distance
 - PLUS = paid on a whole day calendar basis for the allowable time, not to exceed the actual days traveled if less than authorized travel days

PCS

Member and Dependents Travel and Transportation

1. MALT RATES PAYABLE (U5105B-1)
 - Based on the number of authorized travelers in the POC
 - \$0.24 per mile when one traveler occupies the POC
 - \$0.17 per mile when two travelers occupy the same POC
 - \$0.19 per mile when three travelers occupy the same POC
 - \$0.20 per mile when four or more travelers occupy the same POC

PCS

Member and Dependents Travel and Transportation

Flat Per Diem Allowance Payable

(Flat per diem rates, no receipts required)

(U5105B-2 & U 5210)

1. Member = CONUS Rate
2. Spouse = 75% if travel with member
3. Spouse = CONUS Rate
4. Dependents = 75% 12 years/older
5. Dependents = 50% under 12 years

PCS

Household Goods (HHG) Transportation

1. Eligibility (U5305)
 - Member with “orders” to retire; and
 - HHG were in the member’s possession before the effective date of orders
2. Basic Entitlement (U5310)
 - Transportation of HHG from old PDS to HOS (entire weight in one trip)
3. Home of Selection (HOS)
 - ✓ You must select before shipment of HHG

PCS

Household Goods (HHG) Transportation

2. Basic Entitlement (U5310) continued...
 - ✓ Authorized from PDS, HOR, PLEAD, HOS
 - ✓ time limit = “1 YEAR from effective date of retirement orders”
3. Exceptions:
 - ✓ May extend “shipment” of HHG

PCS

Household Goods (HHG) Transportation

4. Professional Books, Papers, and Equipment
 - ✓ Not charged against weight allowance
 - ✓ Pack and Weigh Separately from HHG
 - ✓ YOU MUST DECLARE THIS BEFORE YOU MOVE YOUR HHG
5. DITY (Do IT Yourself) = PPT (U5320D)
 - ✓ **95%**
 - ✓ PHS-4013-1 “Application for Shipment of HHG”
 - ✓ Weight Tickets/Certificate
 - ✓ Pamphlet 11 – “Appendix”

PCS

STORAGE

1. Non-Temporary Storage

- ✓ At point of "ORIGIN"
- ✓ ONE YEAR from effective date of retirement
 - Medical on date of retirement (one year after hospital discharge or treatment whichever is longer)
 - During ONE YEAR period (only time of treatment during that year for extension)

2. Temporary Storage

- ✓ 90 days
- ✓ Only if **"NO"** NTS is used

Entitlement Summary

- ✓ *MALT PLUS if contract carrier not used (mileage and per diem)*
- ✓ *ONE YEAR from effective date of retirement to ship HHG*
- ✓ *ONE YEAR of Non-Temporary Storage at point of origin*
- ✓ *Dislocation Allowance is **NOT** authorized*
- ✓ *Temporary Lodging Expense is **NOT** authorized*
