
### Step-by-step instructions on how to obtain CE credit on TCEOnline


- Visit CDC's Training and Continuing Education Online system found at (http://www2a.cdc.gov/TCEOnline/)
- Log in as a participant by typing your log in name and password. Remember, passwords are case sensitive. The first time you use the online system, you will need to log in as new participant and create a participant profile. If you have difficulty logging in, please visit the "Help Page" or e-mail ce@cdc.gov.



• If you view this webinar between June 22 and July 27, 2015, log on to TCEOnline by July 27, 2015 and do a keyword search for EC1956C (see screenshot). If you view the archived webinar after July 27, 2015, do a keyword search for WD1956C by July 28, 2017.



- Select the course titled <u>Emerging Issues in Sexually Transmitted Diseases: 2015 STD Treatment Guidelines Webinar: An</u>
  <u>Overview by CDC and the NNPTC</u> (EC1956C or Web on Demand WD1956C). Click on the course link to open the registration page. Scroll down to the box that says **Register Here**.
- Click on the type of Continuing Education that you would like to receive and then submit. If you only need a certificate of participation, please select "Audit."



- Three demographic guestions will come up. Complete the guestions and then Submit.
- Select "Click Here if you have viewed the webinar and would like to complete the evaluation and posttest.



#### **Continuing Medical Education (CME):**
