
Influenza Activity in the United States, February 2008*

















National Summary, 2007-08




Percentage of Visits for ILI & ARI Reported by Sentinel Providers and BioSense Outpatient Facilities, National Summary




Pneumonia and Influenza Mortality for 122 U.S. Cities



Surveillance for Deaths among Children with Laboratory-Confirmed Influenza Virus Infection, 2007-08 Season

- As of February 23, 2008, CDC has received 24 reports of influenza-associated deaths among children <18 years old
 - Median age 4.2 years (range, 29 days – 15 years)
 - Of 18 tested for bacterial coinfection, 9 had *S. aureus* invasive infection
 - 5 MRSA
 - Vaccination status
 - Unvaccinated or unknown (15)
 - Ineligible (< 6 months old) (3)
 - Vaccinated (1)
 - Partially vaccinated (1)
 - Unknown (4)
- 2006-2007: 73 deaths
- 2005-2006: 47 deaths
- 2004-2005: 46 deaths
- 2003-2004: 153 deaths
