## WEST AFRICA Ebola Outbreak

Largest Ebola outbreak in history Likely host = bats

2 in 5 people who got Ebola in this outbreak died.

How do you get Ebola? Direct contact with

Body fluids of a person who is sick with or has died from Ebola (blood, vomit, pee, poop, sweat, semen, spit, other fluids)

- **2 Objects contaminated with the virus** (needles, medical equipment)
  - **3** Infected fruit bats or primates (apes and monkeys)

4 Possibly semen from a man who has recovered from Ebola (by having oral, vaginal, or anal sex)

### Symptoms

Symptoms can appear from 2 to 21 days after exposure.

- Fever
  Stomach pain
- Headache
  Unexplained bleeding
- Fatigue
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- or bruising
- Muscle pain

# When is someone able to spread the disease to others?

A person is only contagious after Ebola symptoms begin.

After 21 days, if an exposed person does not develop symptoms, they will not become sick with Ebola.
