


Below you will find general program information related to members enrolled and members certified for treatment of health conditions in the WTC Health Program.

Overall Enrollment: Responders and Survivors*





On September 29, 2011, 4,742 Survivors were likewise "grandfathered". The chart above depicts enrollment from the beginning of the Program, starting with "grandfathered" members and the cumulative addition of new members each quarter. The date labels correspond to the end of the quarter (i.e., September 2018 represents cumulative members through June 30th, 2018).

New Enrollees Past 24 Months*



New Enrollees - Responders and Survivors Past 24 Months




WTC Health Program Enrollment by Member Type*





WTC Health Program Member Type by Gender*









Top 10 Certified Conditions*





Top 15 Certified Cancers*












