
The **VERB Make-It-Up** program is designed to supplement your children's core physical education lessons and after school activities. To meet these goals, the recreational facility and your child need help from you.

Here's what you can do:


- Talk with your child about his or her current physical activities, suggest new ones your child might like and try a new activity with them.
