About the 2016 State Estimate Web Tables Supplement to NCHS Data Brief No. 296

The Long-Term Care Statistics Branch is pleased to release state estimate Web tables about adult day services center (ADSC) participants, using data from the third wave of the National Study of Long-Term Care Providers (NSLTCP) conducted in 2016 by the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS). **These Web tables about ADSC participants complement Data Brief 296.** Table 1 provides state estimates of the characteristics presented in Data Brief 296, and Table 2 provides the standard errors for those estimates.

Estimates are presented as percentages. Data are presented in the state Web tables only if they meet NCHS confidentiality standards. Footnotes are included in the state Web tables to indicate estimates that do not meet confidentiality standards. The data sources and methodology used to develop the state Web tables are the same as those used for Data Brief 296. For more information on the data source and methodology, see the "Data source and methods" section in Data Brief 296.

About NSLTCP

NSLTCP provides reliable, accurate, relevant, and timely statistical information to support and inform long-term care services policy, research, and practice. The main goals of NSLTCP are to: (1) estimate the supply, provision, and use of paid, regulated long-term care services in five major sectors; (2) estimate key policy-relevant characteristics of providers and service users, and provider practices; (3) produce national and state estimates, where feasible; (4) compare estimates among sectors; and (5) monitor trends over time.

NSLTCP comprises two components: (1) survey data collected by NCHS on assisted living and similar residential care communities and residents, and on ADSCs and participants; and (2) administrative data on nursing homes and residents, home health agencies and patients, and hospices and patients obtained from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services. The restricted 2016 survey data files for the residential care community and ADSC sectors are available through the NCHS Research Data Center (https://www.cdc.gov/nchs/nsltcp/nsltcp_rdc.htm).

The ADSC survey was conducted between August 2016 and February 2017. NSLTCP uses a multimode survey protocol with mail, Web, and computer-assisted telephone follow-up for nonresponse. The

questionnaires included survey items on provider characteristics such as ownership, size, services offered, selected practices, and staffing, in addition to aggregate service-user characteristics such as age, sex, race, and the number of participants needing assistance with activities of daily living. Two versions of the questionnaire were used, each containing: (1) survey items included on both questionnaires that were asked of all respondents, which can be used to produce national and state estimates, and (2) survey items unique to each questionnaire that can be used to produce national estimates only. The current document includes variables that can be estimated at the state level.

RTI International collected the survey data under contract to NCHS. The 2016 ADSC mail questionnaires and survey documentation are available from: https://www.cdc.gov/nchs/nsltcp/nsltcp_questionnaires.htm.

The sampling frame obtained from the National Adult Day Services Association had 5,349 ADSCs that self-identified as adult day care, adult day services, or adult day health services centers. After removing duplicates, the final frame consisted of 5,348 ADSCs, all of which were included in the data collection efforts. Of the 4,586 in-scope and presumed in-scope ADSCs, 2,836 completed the survey questionnaire, for an overall response rate of 61.8% (calculated using the American Association for Public Opinion Research [AAPOR] Response Rate 4 as the ratio of all in-scope and responding ADSCs to all screened in-scope ADSCs and centers estimated to be in-scope based on the eligibility rate).
