The percentages in this table were calculated by dividing the number of COVID-19 deaths for each race and Hispanic Origin group by the total number of COVID-19 deaths. Percentages may not sum to 100 due to rounding. Data during this period are incomplete because of the lag in time between when the death occurred and when the death certificate is completed, submitted to NCHS and processed for reporting purposes. This delay can range from 1 week to 8 weeks or more. The distribution of deaths involving COVID-19 by race/ethnicity shown on this table should not be compared to the race/ethnicity distribution of the U.S. population because COVID-19 deaths are concentrated in certain geographic locations where the racial and ethnic population distribution differs from that of the United States overall.
