

## Clinical Final Classification

### **Description**

This data set includes the final clinical classification and exclusionary status of Wichita clinical study participants. Five participants don't have classification and exclusion results because they did not take or complete DIS evaluation. The details of how participants were classified and their exclusionary status were determined are described in the publications listed below.

Note: This is the fatigue status classification at the time of the 2-day hospital study. It is **NOT** the enrollment classification identified from the 4-year longitudinal surveillance study of CFS in Wichita. Refer to [Vernon 2006] for details.
