

## **Life Experiences Survey (LES)**

### **Description**

*Life Experiences Survey* (LES) is a self-reported structured interview [Sarason 1978] that takes 10 minutes to complete. It assesses major life events in the past year. This data set includes three LES subscale scores.

Refer to the data codebook for the detailed information of each variable.

### **Study Sample**

223 participants

### **Data Collection Methods**

LES were administered in clinic by trained psychiatric interviewers. The scores were derived from the raw responses later.
