

## Importing Procedure Data for Outpatient Procedure Component using a Comma-Separated Value (.csv) File

**NOTE: The procedure import file specifications contained in this document were rolled out in NHSN version 9.0. NHSN version 9.0 was deployed to production on 09/22/2018 to begin data entry for procedures with a procedure date of 11/01/2018 and going forward. Ambulatory Surgery Centers will not be able to import procedure data according to these specifications prior to that date.**

NHSN recommends using a comma-separated value (csv) file to import procedure data but will also allow importation of procedure data in an American Standard Code for Information Interchange (ASCII) comma delimited text file format. Import files can be generated from different external sources, such as databases or hospital information systems.

- The default import option allows the importation of procedures where the procedure date occurs in a month for which a Monthly Reporting Plan (MRP) exists and specifies the NHSN Procedure Category in the import file record.
- To import records for procedures not in the MRP, you must specify which procedures to include.

### **Guidance for .csv/ASCII Import:**

1. Data **must** be imported with a header row and the header names **must** match the variable names as they appear in the table below. The fields may be imported in any order.
2. The .csv/ASCII file format defined in the table below requires commas between fields, even if no data values exist (for example, optional or empty fields).
3. For operative procedures of the same procedure category that are performed via separate incisions during the same trip to the operating room, separate Denominator for Procedure forms are required ([SSI Denominator for Procedure Reporting Instruction #6](#)). Refer to the NHSN Procedure Category table below for the procedure categories that can have multiple procedures.
4. There should be a unique procedure duration for operative procedures of the same procedure category that are performed via separate incisions during the same trip to the operating room. To document the duration of the procedures, indicate the procedure/surgery start time to procedure/surgery finish time for each procedure separately or, alternatively, take the total time for the procedures and split it evenly between the procedures ([SSI Denominator for Procedure Reporting Instruction #6](#)).
5. The imported data must be a procedure listed in the [NHSN Current Procedural Terminology \(CPT\) Procedure Category Codes Mapping](#).
6. If importing Surgeon Codes, all surgeon codes must be set-up in NHSN prior to importing.
7. If importing Custom Fields, these fields must be set-up in NHSN prior to importing data into these fields.
8. If the optional Procedure Comment field has text that contain commas, this text must be placed in double quotation marks - at the beginning and end of the string of text (e.g., "with allograft, dowels, plates").

9. When creating .csv/ASCII files, non-printable characters (such as blank spaces before or after the data) must be excluded, as they may cause the data to be improperly imported and result in errors.
10. Data must be entered in all “Required” fields (marked with an asterisk in NHSN) for both in-plan and off-plan procedure records.
11. Fields marked as “Optional for Import” allow an incomplete record to be imported. ***Note: For in-plan procedure records, an “Optional for Import” field is considered required and must be completed. These fields can be completed in NHSN through manual edit.***

\*Values for weight and height can be either in pounds and feet/inches or in kilograms and meters. We do not recommend using both as the system will automatically convert the other.

†The character length for non-date fields represents the *maximum* number of characters allowed, provided the appropriate values are imported according to the NHSN protocols. Values with a shorter character length may be allowed (e.g., the patient ID can be less than 15 characters).
