Compensation Part B Cases w/ Final Decision to Accept

- Accepted Dose Reconstruction Cases 9,704
 - > \$1.4 Billion in Compensation
- Accepted SEC Cases 23,480
 - \$3.5 Billion in Compensation
- Cases Accepted Based on SEC Status and POC ≥ 50% 857
 - \$128.6 Million in Compensation
- Totals: All Accepted SEC, Dose Reconstruction Cases, and Combined – 34,041
 - > \$5.1 Billion in Compensation


Part B – Status & Location of NIOSH Referrals

- 48,485 Cases Referred to NIOSH for Dose Reconstruction
- 43,357 Cases Returned to DOL from NIOSH
 - > 37,358 with Dose Reconstruction
 - > 5,999 without Dose Reconstruction
- 2,128 Cases Currently at NIOSH
 - > 1,524 Initial /Original Referrals
 - > 604 Reworks or Returns


Part B Cases w/ Dose Reconstruction and Final Decision


Chart - Part B Cases w/ a Final Decision

The top 4 worksites generating new Part B EEOICPA cases (10/1/2015-2/29/2016)




