Updates cont'd

- Authorized representative workshop in May in Kennewick, WA
- 1-day, Sandia site-specific DR and SEC workshop with ATL in June in Albuquerque, NM
- 2-day DR and SEC workshop with ATL set for September in Cincinnati
- Authorized representative workshop set for October in Cincinnati



Cases

- 49,422 cases to NIOSH from Department of Labor (DOL)
 - 1,087 at NIOSH for dose reconstruction (DR)
 - 870 administratively closed
- 47,465 returned to DOL

Note: All data as of August 16, 2018



Cases cont.

- -42,428 submitted with DR to DOL
 - 1,559 pulled from DR by DOL
 - 3,478 pulled for SEC



Cases cont.

- 1,087 active cases at NIOSH for DR
 - 341 in DR process
 - 163 initial draft DR reports with claimants
 - 583 cases in DR development



PC Summary

- —42,428 DRs sent back for final adjudication
 - **11,761** PC ≥ 50%
 - **30,667** PC < 50%



DOE records Requests

- —**130** outstanding
- 2 more than 60 days



Summary of first 20,000 DRs

- —**19,580** claims at DOL
 - 770 pulled for DOL issues
 - 2,062 pulled for SEC
- —16,748 submitted with DR



Summary of first 20,000 DRs cont.

- -387 claims at NIOSH
- 357 administratively closed
 - 11 with claimants (1 initial, 10 DOL returns)
 - 19 DRs in process (1 initial, 18 DOL returns)
- 33 claim numbers deleted
