Compensation Part B Cancer Cases w/ Final Decision to Accept

- Accepted Dose Reconstruction Cases 10,628 > \$1.6 Billion in Compensation
- Accepted SEC Cases 26,494 > \$4 Billion in Compensation
- Cases Accepted Based on SEC Status and POC ≥ 50% 1,038 > \$156 Million in Compensation
- Totals: All Accepted SEC, Dose Reconstruction Cases, and **Combined –** 38,160
 - > \$5.7 Billion in Compensation


Status & Location of NIOSH Referrals

- 1,698 Cases Currently at NIOSH




