Contracts, Staffing

- Hired one health physicist due to retirement
- Another health physicist will be retiring this month so we will begin the recruitment and hiring process later this year

Record Requests to Department of Energy

- 160 outstanding
- 16 more than 60 days

Case status report (current as of August 9, 2021)

- 53,392 cases to NIOSH from DOL
- 51,653 returned to DOL
 - 772 at NIOSH for DR
 - 967 administratively closed
- 46,397 submitted DOL with DR
 - 1,689 pulled from DR by DOL
 - 3,567 pulled for Special Exposure Cohort (SEC)

Probably of Causation Summary

- 46,397* DRs sent for final adjudication
 - 12,564 greater than 50 percent
 - **33,824** less than 50 percent

Active Cases

- 772* active at NIOSH for DR
 - 578 in the DR process
 - 91 initial draft DR reports with claimants
 - 103 cases preparing for DR

IT Modernization

- DOL continues to forward cases to us for dose reconstruction
- DOE continues to collect personal dosimetry for cases and send that to us
- ORAU continues to complete dose reconstructions for cases already received
- The Dose Reconstruction production and approval process is manual
 - Focusing on terminal cases
- Site research database access is extremely limited. Once DCAS has access, so will the Advisory Board and SCA.
