

Program Profile

❑ 3-year Cooperative Agreement

- Funding agency and grantee have specific roles and responsibilities that ensure that entities work collaboratively to achieve overall goal of the agreement.
- Project Period: September 30, 2011 – September 29, 2014

❑ Competitive Application Process

- Received 53 responsive applications
- Eligible entities included:
 - Non-profit (other than institution or higher education)
 - For-profit organizations (other than small businesses)
 - Small, minority, and women-owned businesses
 - Colleges and/or Universities
 - Research institutions
 - Hospitals
 - Community-based organizations
 - Faith based organizations
- Objective review panel

Purpose

- ❑ Provide resources to select organizations to establish or enhance existing support services**
 - Development of patient navigation programs**
- ❑ Development of programs and resources related to psychosocial support**
 - Development of resources to enhance support given to family members/caregivers**
 - Develop tools and resources to increase patient and provider knowledge**

John C. Lincoln

- ❑ Build and maintain an online comprehensive database**
- ❑ Provide educational events throughout the state to increase breast health awareness**
- ❑ Facilitate survivor support groups**
- ❑ Address additional needs identified in the needs assessment**

Louisiana State University

- ❑ Conduct a literature review, survey, resource assessment, and gaps analysis to determine top needs of YBCS**
- ❑ Develop a network of providers to respond to needs**
- ❑ Develop a community of collaboration and engagement for learning**
- ❑ Develop a system that aids in the rapid identification of YBCS and facilitates navigation into services**

University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill

- ❑ **Assess the needs and utilization of structured support services**
- ❑ **Identify existing barriers to routine needs assessment, and use of supportive care services**
- ❑ **Modify existing systems to facilitate assessment for, and utilization of, support services**
- ❑ **Develop educational materials for patients, families and staff**
- ❑ **Disseminate information via their existing navigator and lay navigator network, teleconferencing system, and through educational sessions at UNC and in the community.**
