


Texas Food Deserts by County : 2005

58 of the 258 counties in Texas are listed as Food Deserts according to the FDA in 2005.




Healthy Food Availability, Food Deserts, 2005

How accessible is healthy food? This map shows the counties which have less than 30% of grocery stores are adequately staffed and stocked with healthy food.





Population <4000, Food Desert, 2005

Shaded counties represented are based on population from Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and the University of Wisconsin





Poor Health Rankings >200: 2005
