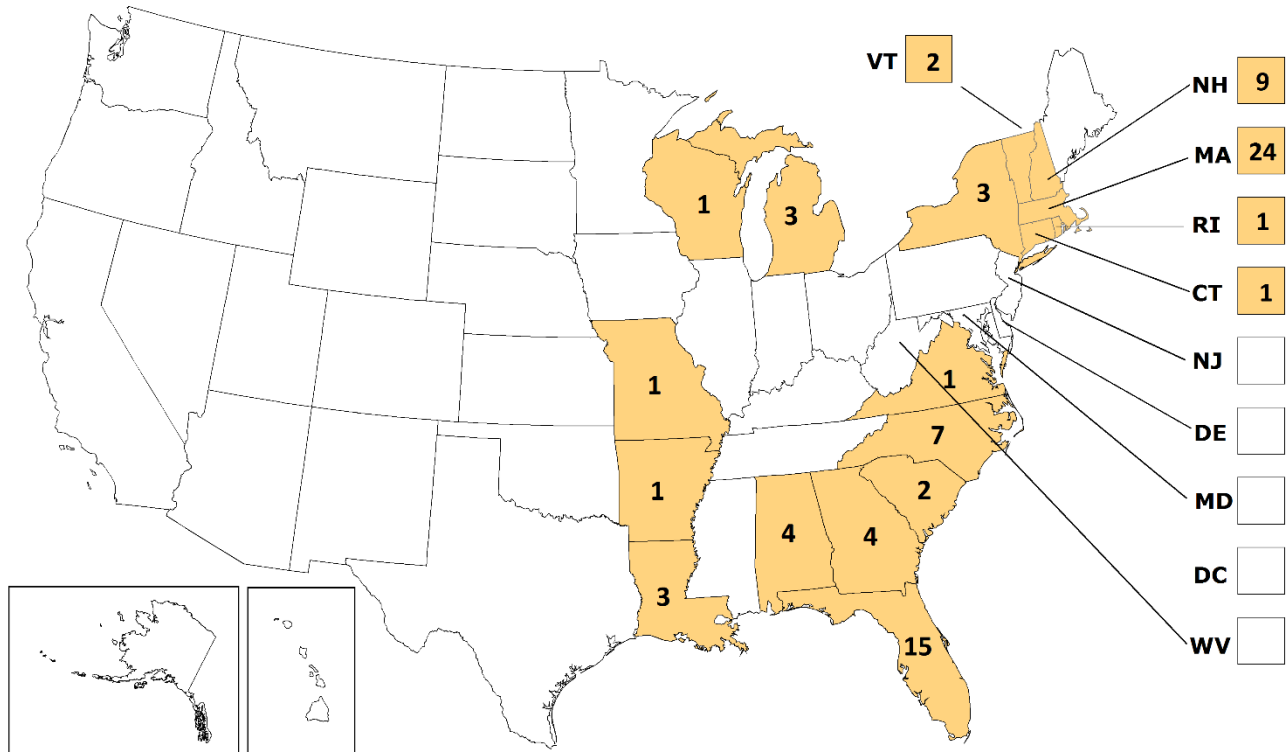


## Eastern equine encephalitis virus neuroinvasive disease cases reported by state, 2004–2013
