Director, National Center for HIV/AIDS, Viral Hepatitis, STD, and TB Prevention (NCHHSTP)

The CDC seeks exceptional candidates for Director, National Center for HIV/AIDS, Viral Hepatitis, STD, and TB Prevention (NCHHSTP). As a senior leader at CDC, the Director will play a key role in the enhancement of public health sciences centered on HIV/AIDS, Viral Hepatitis, STD, and TB Prevention.

CDC is an internationally recognized leader in public health surveillance and epidemiology in all areas of public health including infectious diseases, environmental hazards, chronic non-communicable diseases, lifestyle-associated disease, and vital statistics. The National Center for HIV/AIDS, Viral Hepatitis, STD, and TB Prevention (NCHHSTP) is one of the larger centers at CDC, with over 1,800 full-time employees and contractors and a budget of approximately \$1 billion.

NCHHSTP is composed of an Office of the Director (OD) and five divisions: the Division of HIV/AIDS Prevention, the Division of Viral Hepatitis, the Division of STD Prevention, the Division of TB Elimination and the Division of Adolescent and School Health. Although the divisions have their own missions, the National Center OD provides leadership to help coordinate their efforts and foster collaboration. Center staff work in collaboration with governmental and nongovernmental partners at community, state, national, and international levels to accomplish the NCHHSTP mission.

Major Duties And Responsibilities

The Director, NCHHSTP will have broad operating authority and is responsible for overall planning, direction and management of NCHHSTP. The Director will participate in overall management planning sessions in which program direction, feasibility of program changes and expansions, and allocation of funds are considered. He/she will evaluate the effectiveness and efficiency of program operations in relation to objectives and in relation to legislative, budgetary and program planning, collaborating with other top management officials on the development and implementation of long range plans and their budget impact. Through subordinate leaders, the Director will manage the various NCHHSTP program areas to achieve CDC goals and objectives. The Director performs long-range planning and justifies the resources necessary for NCHHSTP internal operations, advancing the state of the science in HIV/AIDS, Viral Hepatitis, STD, and TB Prevention through intramural and extramural research and development.

He/she will plan and conduct collaborative studies with the World Health Organization, the Pan American Health Organization; state and local health departments; other Federal, state, and local government agencies; industry and labor groups; academia; etc.

Required Qualifications

- MD, PhD or equivalent degree
- Expertise in the field of HIV/AIDS, Viral Hepatitis, STDs, TB or other related public health programs
- Extensive, proven experience leading a national recognized public health program


