

Puerto Rico, 2011

Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Puerto Rico reported 254 cases in 2011.
- RATES: Puerto Rico ranked 6 among 51 areas (48 states; Washington, DC; and 2 territories) reporting at least one case of P&S syphilis with 6.8 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 4.5 cases per 100,000 population.

Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex


- In Puerto Rico, the rate among males was 13.3 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 8.2 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.9 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 1.0 per 100,000.

Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by race/ethnicity


Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Puerto Rico reported 2 cases in 2011.
- RATES: Puerto Rico ranked 19 among 25 areas (23 states; Washington, DC; and 1 territory) reporting at least one case of congenital syphilis with a rate of 4.3 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.5 cases per 100,000.
