Chapter 10 (Human Papillomavirus)

Inclusion of recommendation for vaccination of males with quadrivalent human papillomavirus vaccine. See *MMWR* December 23, 2011 / 60(50);1705-1708.

Chapter 11 (Influenza)

Information about intradermal Fluzone influenza vaccine was added. See *MMWR* August 26, 2011 / 60(33);1128-1132.

Chapter 13 (Meningococcal Disease)

Addition of recommendation for meningococcal conjugate vaccine of certain 9-23 month old children. See *MMWR* October 14, 2011 / 60(40);1391-1392.

Chapter 15 (Pertussis)

Information about Tdap vaccination of pregnant women was added. See *MMWR* October 21, 2011 / 60(41);1424-1426.

Chapter 18 (Rotavirus)

Addition of a history of intussusception as a contraindication for rotavirus vaccination. See *MMWR* October 21, 2011 / 60(41);1427-1427.

Chapter 20 (Tetanus)
