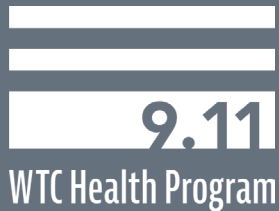




Are you eligible to enroll in the World Trade Center Health Program as a 9/11 Responder?

If you volunteered, performed response and recovery efforts, or otherwise responded to 9/11 in New York City, at the Pentagon, or at the Shanksville, Pennsylvania sites you could be eligible for no-cost medical monitoring and treatment related to your 9/11 experience.

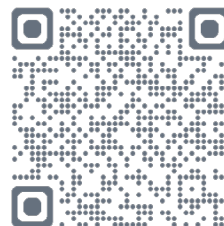

Responder Eligibility





Check the boxes that describe your 9/11 experience:



Did you volunteer or participate in any of the following rescue and recovery efforts during or in the months after 9/11?

- Rescue, recovery, restoration, debris cleanup, site security, administrative support, or other related response services
- As a first responder, uniformed service member, or direct aid to responders
- Media occupations
- Performing Medical Examiner's Office work where you handled human remains or dust covered body bags



Did you perform any of these rescue and recovery efforts at any of the following 9/11 response sites?

- In New York City (see map)
- Pentagon
- Shanksville, PA crash site



Did you perform any of these rescue and recovery efforts during the following time periods?*

- At any of the former WTC sites between September 11, 2001, and July 31, 2002
- At the Pentagon site between September 11, 2001 and November 19, 2001
- At the Shanksville, PA site between September 11, 2001 and October 3, 2001

* Minimum hour requirements vary

If you checked any box above, you may be eligible to apply.



If you were in the area but did not check a box, you may still be eligible to apply as a **Survivor**.

WTC Responder Eligibility, Lower Manhattan Area Map

The Responder eligibility area includes the area of Lower Manhattan south of Canal Street.

Shaded purple area is the WTC Responder eligibility area. White circle is the World Trade Center site.

Other sites in the NYC Disaster Area include:

- Lower Manhattan (South of Canal Street)
- Ground Zero
- Staten Island Landfill
- Certain Barge Loading Piers
- PATH Tunnel
- NYC Chief Medical Examiner's Office*

*Must have handled human remains or dust covered body bags
