2019–2020 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Data from Veterans* in 46 States, Puerto Rico, and the District of Columbia: People Aged 45 Years and Older

1 in 9 veterans 45 years and older are experiencing Subjective Cognitive Decline



SCD is self-reported MEMORY PROBLEMS that have been GETTING WORSE over the past year.

32% of veterans with SCD had to give up day-to-day activities



86% of veterans with SCD have at least one chronic condition

nearly one in three of veterans with SCD say it interfered with social activities, work or volunteering



less than half of veterans with SCD have discussed their symptoms with a healthcare provider

29% of veterans with SCD need help with household tasks
