Nearly 1 in 5

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability adults are caregivers

CAREGIVING CAN BE

LENGTHY Nearly half have provided care for at least two years

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INTENSE A third have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

60% are women

20% are 65 years old or older

39% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

23% of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia



HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?



80% manage household tasks

Over half assist with personal care



FUTURE CAREGIVERS

Nearly 1 in 7 **NON-CAREGIVERS** expect to **BECOME CAREGIVERS** within 2 years
