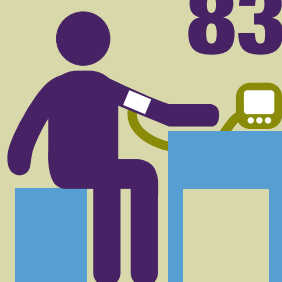
Subjective Cognitive Decline
