## **WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?**

60% are women

14% are 65 years old or older

**33%** are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

**9%** of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia

**80%** manage household tasks

**Over 50%** assist with personal care
