2015–2018 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Data from Men in 44 States, Puerto Rico, and the District of Columbia.



1 in 5 Men are caregivers

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

CAREGIVING CAN BE

LENGTHY
Nearly Half have provided care for at least two years



INTENSE
25% have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?



Over 75% manage household tasks

Nearly half assist with personal care



WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

18% are 65 years old or older

38% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

8% are providing care to someone with dementia



FUTURE CAREGIVERS

1 in 7 NON-CAREGIVERS expect to **BECOME CAREGIVERS** within 2 years
