2018 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Data

**CAREGIVERS** provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

### **WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?**

**59%** are women

**27%** are 65 years old or older

**44%** are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

**11%** of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia

## **FUTURE CAREGIVERS**

1 in 9 **NON-CAREGIVERS** expect to **BECOME CAREGIVERS** within 2 years
