CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

59% are women

27% are 65 years old or older

44% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

11% of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia

FUTURE CAREGIVERS

1 in 9 **NON-CAREGIVERS** expect to **BECOME CAREGIVERS** within 2 years
