

## **mPINC State Reports**

The mPINC State Reports provide a summary of the strengths in that state's facilities' breastfeeding support as well as the areas most in need of improvement. State Reports also identify opportunities better protect, promote, and support breastfeeding mothers and infants statewide and provide complete aggregated state-level data for each practice and policy area covered in the mPINC survey.

State Reports are provided to state partners representing health departments and other agencies, as well as health professionals and organizations. CDC provides this report so state leadership may better identify, understand, and take action on their individual states' priority areas.

The mPINC State Report is a highly targeted publication designed to specifically to:

1. Communicate directly with the state partners most able to influence hospitals' practices and policies across the state;
2. Address specific barriers to evidence-based maternity care related to breastfeeding in an objective, evidence-based, and positive manner; and
3. Increase state-wide prevalence of hospital practices and policies that are positively associated with improved breastfeeding outcomes.
