Narration: Stay safe from COVID-19.

Additional description: Winnie is holding a mask.

She is an American Indian girl with cerebral palsy who uses a wheelchair.

Narration: Wear a mask so you won't get sick.

Additional description: Winnie's dad shows her how to wear a mask.

Winnie puts her mask on.

Narration: Wear your mask when you go to school.

Additional description: Winnie leaves for school.

Dad waves goodbye.

Narration: Wear your mask on the bus.

Additional description: Winnie rides the school bus.

Her friend Alice sits behind her.

Narration: Wear your mask in the classroom.

Additional description: Winnie is in a classroom with her friends Alice and Sam.

Sam is wearing a mask, just like Winnie.

Narration: Some people wear masks.

Some people don't wear masks.

Additional description: Here's Winnie, and here are the kids in her class.

Some kids wear masks, and other kids don't.

Narration: That's okay!

You can wear a mask so you won't get sick.

Additional description: Winnie points to her mask.

Narration: You can take your mask off to eat lunch.

Additional description: Winnie, Alice, and Sam eat lunch in the cafeteria.

Their masks are on the table.

Narration: When you're done eating, put your mask back on.

Additional description: Winnie puts her mask back on.

Narration: Keep your mask on for the rest of your day at school.

Additional description: Winnie and her friends are back in the classroom.

Narration: Wear your mask when friends come to your house, too.

Additional description: Winnie, Alice, and Sam play in Winnie's living room.

Narration: When your friends go home, you can take your mask off.

Additional description: Winnie and her dad look out the window.

They see Alice and Sam waving goodbye. Winnie is not wearing her mask anymore.
