Vaccination Video Script

June 24, 2021

- **Main message/behavioral recommendation:** Get a COVID-19 shot.
- **Appeal:** The shot will keep you from getting very sick so you can see your friends.
- **Note:** All words are sight words (per [Fry 1000 list](#)) except: COVID-19, mask, shot, sick, sore, tired

Text/Narration

Stay safe from COVID-19.

Get a COVID-19 shot.

Doctors say the shot will help keep you from getting very sick from COVID-19.

When you get your shot, you will wear a mask.

You will need to wait until it's your turn.

Remember to keep a safe distance from other people.

A doctor will give you a COVID-19 shot.

The shot will help keep you from getting very sick from COVID-19.

After you get your shot, you may feel tired.

Your arm may be sore.

You will feel better in a few days.

Sometimes, people need 2 shots.

If you need 2 shots, you will go back another day.

The doctor will give you a shot again.

It is the same as the first time.

Your friends can get a COVID-19 shot, too.

A few weeks after everyone gets their shots,
it is safe to see your friends again.
