

Management of Dengue

Patients must meet all criteria of Group A or at least one of the criteria for Group B or Group C, to be assigned to a group.

Dengue Management Groups

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Does not have coexisting conditions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Has coexisting condition: diabetes mellitus, renal failure, or is infant, pregnant, or elderly 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Severe bleeding, as determined by clinician
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Receives adequate volume of oral fluids 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Has challenging social circumstances, such as living alone or living far away without a reliable means of transport 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Severe organ impairment: AST or ALT \geq 1000 or impaired consciousness
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Passes urine at least once every 6 hours 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Has stable hematocrit and hemodynamically stable
