Management of Dengue Patients

The following recommendations for management of dengue patients include sending Group A patients home with follow-up guidance and admitting Group B and Group C patients to the hospital for treatment.

Group A	Group B	Group C
 Give anticipatory guidance prior to sending patient home (Refer to patient handout) 	Admit patient to hospital	In addition to Group B management, do the following:
Follow-up daily	Monitor hemodynamic status frequently	Use colloids for refractory shock
Do serial CBCs	Use HCT to determine interventions	Monitor for occult bleeding*
Identify warning signs early	Use isotonic IVFs judiciously	
	Correct metabolic acidosis and electrolyte abnormalities as needed	

^{*}Do not use prophylactic platelet transfusions.
